How to set up features we will be using.

iPad

- Load google docs app.
- Go into settings on iPad.
- Go to Settings→Accessibility→Spoken Content(or Speech).
- Turn on Speak Selection and Speak Screen.

If you scroll down you can change the speaking rate and also change voices if you prefer.

laptop

- sign into google docs.
- Go into the store and download Google Read & Write. (This is a free download and will show up as an icon in the upper right hand corner of google docs.)

Once in google docs

- go to Tools,
- Select voice typing (If not available, make sure you are in a chrome browser and have the dictation or voice settings turned on in the computer settings.)

Helpful apps for those with phones or ipads-

- **Merriam Webster dictionary app**. (We use the thesaurus feature to look up alternate words. Has dictation and a speak back feature.)
- **IEW free app-**has word lists for dress-ups and has structural models.
